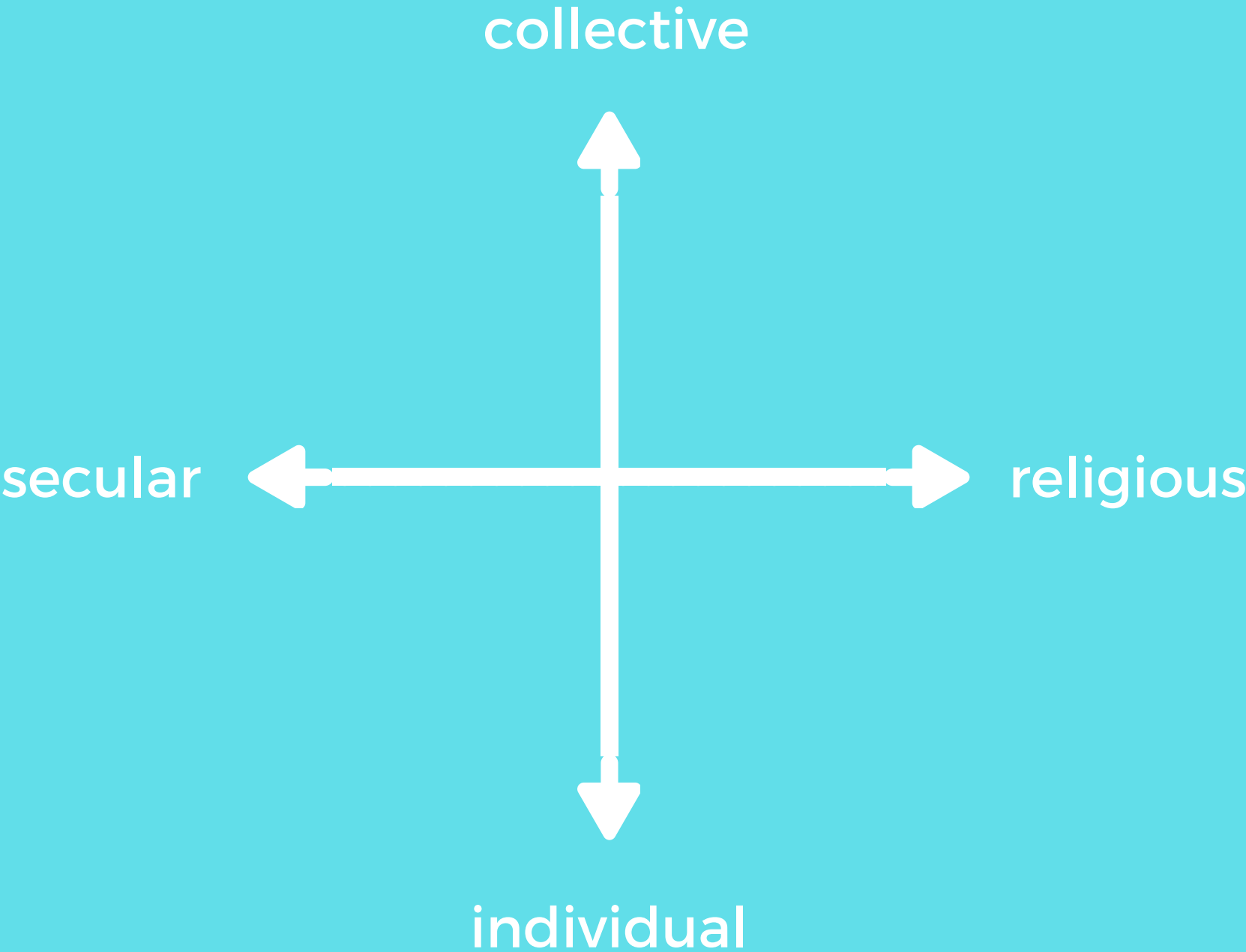




SO, WHAT?

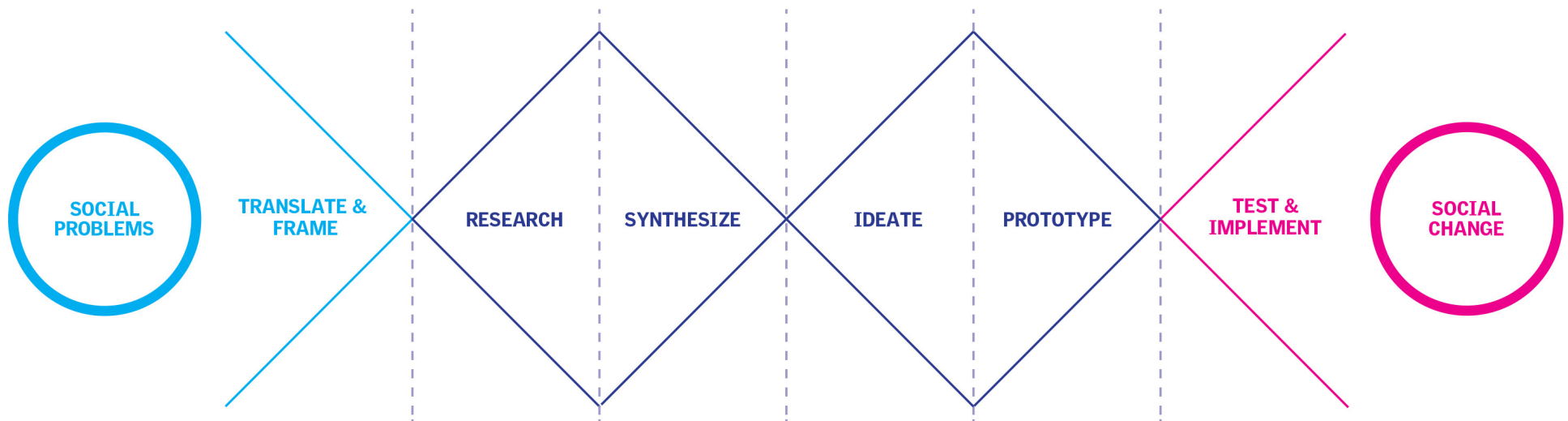
